Cell Phone Struggles:

More Grade 6 and 7 students are starting to struggle to follow our cell phone expectations. Many are needing to be reminded to not bring their phones to the bathroom, play videogames, take pictures, send texts or watch videos during school hours. If your child brings their phone to school, please review the expectations below and have a discussion with them. If they need to use their phone to contact you they simply need to **ask an adult first.**

Expectations:

- In class: Cell phones are away unless the teacher permits students to use them for academic activities.
- At recess: Phones are away (not visible) inside and outside
- At lunch: Phones are away (not visible) inside and outside

Students who are on their phones at recess and lunch may be asked to turn over their phone. They can pick them up at the end of the day from the office. If parents or students are not comfortable with them turning over their device, it should be left at home.

Lost and Found:

Many items were reclaimed during your parent/teacher interview visits, however, the lost and found is exploding with items once again. Items that are not claimed by end of Day on December 15th will be donated or removed. Please have your child check the lost and found regularly or check it out yourself near the main entrance.

Beverage container recycling

The school has set up an account with the Express Drop and Go recycling system at Extra Foods. If you would like to donate your bottles or cans you can follow the simple steps below. It's a very fast and hassle-free way of getting rid of your refundable beverage containers. Donations will go towards paying for field trips, student prizes and other initiatives with a student focus.

- 1. Enter Extra foods and print labels from the self-serve Kiosk near the entrance by simply entering the school phone number (250)747-2009
- 2. Place labels on clear bags (they recommend not larger than 70L) with recycled items.
- 3. Walk/drive to the Return-It bin at the far end of the Extra foods parking lot
- 4. Text the code **TQ0G** (it's a zero not the letter o) number 778 400-5253 to receive a code for the locked door on the sea can.
- 5. Enter the code on the pinpad that is texted back to you.
- 6. Put your bags in the bin
