#### Sledding Hill:

Now that we have some snow, our sledding hill is open. Students who are properly dressed in snow pants, jacket, gloves, boots etc, will be allowed to use the sleds during their allotted time at lunch when conditions are right. Students will be expected to follow the safety rules in order to participate.

#### Adverse Weather/In Days:

With the colder weather arriving it is important that students are dressed for the weather. If it's -14C (real temperature not wind-chill temp) or warmer, students will spend the morning, recess and lunch outside as usual. It is common practice in the district to have an 'in day' for students when temperatures are -15C or colder. Even at -15C or a bit colder, students may be offered some time outside at recess or lunch if it's nice day or not windy. These outings will be for those who are properly dressed and will be for shorter periods of time.

Adverse weather may also impact our bus service. When temperatures are below -32C or roads are deemed unsafe (ice or excess snow), the Transportation Department will likely suspend bus service. Please keep an eye on your email or check our school or district webpages on cold or snowy mornings for bus cancellations.

## Circle of Courage:

At Lakeview we've embraced the Circle of Courage and the virtues of Belonging, Generosity, Independence and Mastery. Starting in January students will be able to earn 'Courage tickets' by demonstrating these virtues. We will be finding ways to recognize, acknowledge and celebrate students when they demonstrate these qualities and make our school a great place to learn.
