Voter Qualifications

If you are not on the List of Registered Electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place and make a declaration that you meet the requirements to be registered as set out below:

RESIDENT ELECTORS:

To register as a Resident Elector you must:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 17, 2026;
- be a Canadian citizen (landed immigrants, permanent residents and corporations are not eligible);
- be a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a resident of School District No. 28 (Quesnel) the day of registration (at time of voting); and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, Resident Electors must produce two pieces of identification (at least one must have your signature) to prove who you are and where you live. Picture identification is not necessary.

Local Government Elections Regulation 380/93 defines acceptable identification, including:

If you do not have ID showing where you live, you must provide at least two pieces of identification that prove who you are (at least one of them must have your signature on it) AND make a solemn declaration as to your place of residence. *Please note that the combined Driver's Licence and Services Card is deemed to be one piece of identification.*

NON-RESIDENT ELECTORS:

To register as a Non-resident Property Elector you must:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 17, 2026;
- be a Canadian citizen (landed immigrants, permanent residents and corporations are not eligible);
- be a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a registered owner of real property in School District No. 28 (Quesnel) for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- not be entitled to register as a Resident Elector in School District No. 28 (Quesnel); and
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

In addition, for Non-resident Property Electors:

- the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust.
- if more than one person is registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the owners, register as a Non-resident Property Elector.

Non-resident Property Electors must produce two pieces of identification as listed above (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, and must also bring evidence that you are entitled to register in relation to the property, including:

- proof of ownership of the property (a recent Title Search); and
- if there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the other property owners.
